

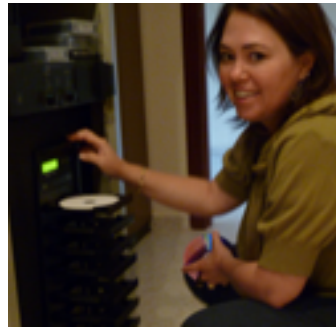
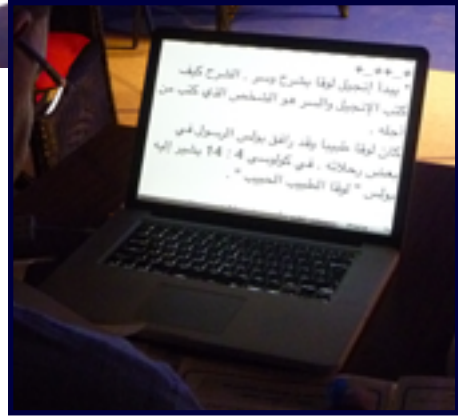
How are YOUR feet?

You may have noticed that there are no photos in this newsletter that show the faces of our Egyptian hosts for the Arabic translations of the Four Gospels project. You would be correct!

We have created a visual representation of The Gospels here at IMM. They are each about 30 minutes in length, are in English and African French and have seen wide use. This four-part series is a clean, classic representation of the Gospels using teaching, historical reenactment, and cultural explanation.

A program host teaches and explains on camera as the Gospel narrative progresses. This host is recorded standing in front of a chromakey wall. The background set only exists on a computer. Like your local weatherman, we can put the host in front of any map, image or action that we want.

The Gospels was created in this way in order to facilitate easy translation, adapt to any studio environment and most importantly, to get the Gospel message into the hands of broadcasters in different parts of the world as quickly as possible.

So in our little basement studio, in our quiet neighborhood outside of Madrid, Spain, we recorded The Gospels to be broadcast in Arabic by a native Arabic speaker.

Our partner will take the completed project and broadcast The Gospels via satellite across the Middle-East and North Africa in the coming months on several channels. The broadcast has a potential viewing audience of 350 million. Percentages are favorable.

When I heard the Arabic words referencing the Gospel message echoing from the audio suite, I realized that Arabic was indeed a beautiful tongue when the words spoke of salvation, new life, and trust in Jesus Christ our Redeemer.
