‘You must be doing something right,’ our Indonesian friend from a broadcast channel said. Our International Media Ministries contact for this channel, a beloved team member handling distribution, Henry Marsh passed away suddenly a few weeks ago. When I described how five other team members have lost family members this past year that was the response. It wasn’t callous; it was affirmation. What IMM does matters more than we can see from the window of the studio here in Spain.

A few hours later at the same media conference, a man from Iran gave a report on the various protests and chaos ensuing as people are fed up with harsh treatment and a lack of rights. He said, ‘We need online media ministry. What you are doing is working! God is at work!’

A small peek at any headlines will tell you that a lot is going on in the world and it can be a lot to take in on any given day. We are able to travel more again and hear about the media needs and the reports of what is going on in other parts of the world. We are hearing that four to five times more people

are interacting via text and email to ask about God, to ask about hope. Jesus came to set people free from the damage and destruction of our broken world. When you lose someone suddenly, it often makes you take stock. It’s not that having a relationship with Jesus will make sure we don’t suffer, but it makes sure we are not alone in our challenges. He gives us a purpose that we know what we do matters and we leave a legacy of hope that humans cannot destroy.

The languages that have passed through our distribution this year are remarkable: Saraiki, Greek, Urdu, Tamil, Arabic, Bulgarian, Albanian, Farsi, Darija, and more. We are humbled to get to share quality stories that engage the heart and soul.

Will you pray for us as we continue to empower translations and short videos and begin also to research a new project? We will partner with Iranians to use the lens of their culture to tell their part in a Bible story: Esther. We will open up to them in story form some of their lost history. This will be a long project and we are glad you go with us. God is at work!
